

# ***Tax Filing Extensions***

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On March 18, 2020, the **Department of the Treasury and the Internal Revenue Service** issued a notice providing relief for taxpayers. This notice postpones the due date for certain Federal income tax payments from April 15, 2020 until **July 15, 2020**.

The due date for filing Federal income tax returns and making Federal income tax payments due April 15, 2020 (including quarter 1 estimated payments) is automatically postponed until **July 15, 2020**. Interest and penalties on such postponed tax filings and payments will not begin to accrue until July 16, 2020.

The **PA Department of Revenue** announced on March 21, 2020, that it has also extended the filing deadline for PA personal income tax returns to July 15, 2020. The Department will also waive penalties and interest on personal income tax payments made through the new deadline.

Many **local taxing agencies** have also indicated that they will extend their filing deadlines until **July 15, 2020**. We will continue to monitor these.
